LIONS MOTORCYCLE EVENT TO BUILD HOMES FOR DISABLED

(July 7, 2010) -- Members of District 11 B1 Michigan Lions Clubs will sponsor the 2nd Annual LIONS ROAR motorcycle run to build homes for disabled people who currently live in substandard conditions. The District began a partnership with Habitat for Humanity in August of 2008.

Starting and finishing at the Town & Country Sports Center at the corner of US 12 and US 127 in Cement City, Michigan, the event will include stops in Lenawee, Washtenaw and Jackson Counties.

Registration will be from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., and the cost will be \$15 per driver and \$10 per passenger.

According to Marshall Lion Mike Dauphinais, Habitat for Humanity committee chairperson, "Success of the fundraiser on **July 31** will allow Lions and Habitat to select their first qualified homeowner from within a district that includes Branch, Calhoun, Hillsdale, Jackson, Lenawee and Washtenaw Counties."
