**Old Business: CORE 4 GRANT**

The LCIF Executive Committee did meet to discuss how and if the partnership would continue with Habitat for Humanity. While they did not approve a block amount of funding for the program over any specific amount of time, the decision was made to continue with the program, under the same criteria. They will continue accepting applications for consideration, until the committee determines otherwise. The District must contribute 25% of the project cost, Habitat must contribute 50%, and LCIF would match the District 25% for qualifying applications. The District may contribute more, but LCIF would still only award 25%.
