**We've collected funds from the Zone Meeting in Inter-Lakes (\$34); Napoleon Pancake Breakfast (\$45.50); Garage Sales in Marshall, Michigan (36.50); Manchester Business Expo (\$36) for a total of \$152. Check #5838 sent to District Treasurer John Krienke on June 5.**

**Since that date we've raised another \$125 in Jackson and \$14 in Marshall. At the end of June, we'll make another check from the Michigan Center Carp Carnival and from a sale at a Jackson church. The booksale has raised \$291 to date with the whole summer ahead of us.**

**The committee has acquired 501c3 status from Lions of Michigan Foundation through Chad McCann on the recommendation of PDG Gary Babcock. We are now the "Lions of District 11-B1 Habitat Fund". Money will continue to be given to the activity fund of District 11-B1 but we will also need to give a report to LOMF.**

**I was able to access a non-public website through the help of Sarah Teare, Grants Manager of Washtenaw County from Nonprofit Enterprise at Work (NEW) in Ann Arbor to identify corporations that have given grants to a.) Disabled; b.) home builds; and c.) Michigan. We've also identified some corporations that have given grants to at least one of the above.**
